## REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age: 17 years
- Valid National ID / Passport
- Class 1 Aeronautical Medical Certificate
- English language knowledge
- Baccalaureate, Vocational Training qualification or entrance exam

## COURSE

- The programme includes 795 hours of theoretical studies and 195 total flight hours.
- Classes are taught in English.
- Once theoretical competencies have been acquired, practical training will begin.
- The student will agree with World Aviation on the schedule for taking the official SENASA exams and the flight test.

## OBJECTIVE

- Obtaining the Airline Transport Pilot Licence ATPL(H) / IR Frozen.
- Providing the knowledge and practical experience required to work as a Pilot/Co-pilot under VFR and IFR conditions in multi-turbine helicopters.
- The student will obtain the Bell 429 type rating with IR rating and PBN privileges.
