PRIVATE PILOT LICENCE



PILOTE PRIVÉ D'AVION

REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age: 17 years
- Valid National ID Card / Passport
- Successful completion of the required medical examination (EASA Class 2)

COURSE

- Preparation to fly safely and efficiently under VFR conditions for leisure and recreational purposes throughout the entire territory of the European Union.
- With this EASA-recognised licence, you will operate as Pilot-in-Command in non-commercial operations, i.e. without remuneration.
- This programme will open the door to further qualifications such as Night Visual Flight (VFR-N), Instrument Flight (IFR) or Flight

OBJECTIVE

- The Private Aeroplane Pilot Programme consists of two phases: (140 hours of theoretical instruction and 45 hours of practical flight training)
- Theoretical training is delivered from Monday to Friday, and practical flight instruction takes place every day of the year from 09:00 until sunset.
- Internal examinations are conducted to ensure that students successfully pass the official AESA examinations.
- Real flight training is carried out using state-of-the-art aircraft, and students will have access to the World Aviation Simulator Centre.

- Administrative management of the licence
- Flight time for one skill test
